STATE AGENCIES

PA GAME COMMISSION - Mike Yeck - Report

• 2021-22 Antlerless Hunting License fee went up \$.07

- Antlerless Licenses have been reduced by 7,000 this season
- May hold 6 doe tags at one time
- Game lands maintenance man hit by an ATV hit and run stable and doing well now.
- Peregrine Falcon may be coming off the endangered list.
- Red tag program (Feb October 2021), may change to corelate with the hunting license year (July 2021 to June 2022). Currently receiving red tags, may change to the land owner getting coupons. The hunter can go to the land owner to request a coupon to purchase a tag to hunt the land. May increase the tags from 1 to 4. The Hunter will be required to report (successful and unsuccessful hunts), not the land owner.
- Mentored hunters age 7 and older can purchase their own bear license. Under the age of 7, the mentor will have
 to transfer their license. For waterfowl need PA migratory bird license in addition to their hunting permit. Hunters
 over the age 16 still need to purchase the federal duck stamp.
- Game Commission Regulatory change straight wall center fire cartridge is now legal in Allegheny County.
- New deputy executive director Dave Mitchell
- Hunter Education on line classes are still available.
- Bears are everywhere New Sewickley twp., North Sewickley twp., Franklin twp. Marion twp., etc.

Jim Marshall – Question was posed to him by a resident living in Industry regarding if PA has an Adult Mentor hunting program. Yes, PA does have a program. Adult Mentor License may be purchased but for 3 consecutive years ONLY then he must take the hunter education class and purchase an adult hunting license after the 3rd year.

Club members recommended that a suggestion be made that the individual join a sportsman club.

- Hunter Trapper Education Instructors recently went through some on-line training classes.

- In 2020 28,025 people certified in hunter trapper education (This is a decrease from 2019 of 9%)
- 176 classes in 2020 pre-covid (This is down 123%)
- "0" fatal HRSI (hunting related shooting incidents) in 2020.
- 22 total incidents 30 % were self-inflicted.
- 1,850 + instructors in the state of PA.
