BASIC BLACK RIFLE

DESCRIPTION

Our Basic Black Rifle class is designed to give the student a thorough introduction to the AR-15 rifle platform geared toward personal protection. During this course, students will learn about one of the most prolific weapon systems used for personal defense by civilians and law enforcement officers across the country. Students will become familiarized with the AR-15 and will learn the basic gun-handling skills that are necessary to safely operate and maintain your rifle.

If you have just purchased an Ar-15 rifle or would like to rent one of ours and want to start off in the right direction, this class is for you. Understanding the rifle inside and out will get you more comfortable with your rifle, and get you ready for the next step.

TOPICS

Students will learn about the history of the AR-15 platform. Get an Understanding of the AR-15 breakdown and Rifle capabilities. Equipment setup and selection, nomenclature, disassembly / reassembly, mechanical operation, care & cleaning, preventive maintenance, zeroing iron sights & electronic sights, different types of operating systems, shooting positions.
