- Bobwhite Quail back in PA; on 3/19/24, Game Commission released 50 bobwhite quail on the grounds of Letterkenny Army Depot in Frankin County.

- Mentored Youth Fishing was March 30th & Beaver County had a great turnout!
- Statewide Opening Day of Trout Season April 6, 2024. Anglers begin fishing at 8:00 am.
 - Regular Season (opening day through Labor Day) anglers may keep up to five trout (combined species) per day measuring at least seven inches long.
- Reminder: cold weather life jacket requirements are in effect from November 1st though April 30th. Anyone aboard a boat 16 feet or less, including all canoes and kayaks, is required to wear a life jacket. Ages 12 and under are always required to wear a life jacket while boating in PA.
